## [Q1]

\*censorship: the practice of officially examining books, movies, etc., and removing parts considered unacceptable for moral, religious, or political reasons

#### Ken:

Censorship on the internet is an important issue these days. Despite some negative effects, I believe that freedom of speech online is essential in a democratic society.

It is true that anonymous comments on social media might cause emotional harm to people and in extreme cases lead to suicide. However, the censoring of comments and opinions on social media could lead to far worse consequences. It means that a government or private organization has to decide which comments and opinions are acceptable or not. It is not always easy to separate valid criticism from abuse. People's right to comment on the actions of powerful people may be restricted.

The regulation of news networks and search engines is even more dangerous. Most people these days get their information about world events from the internet. If access to news networks and search engines is restricted, citizens may not learn the truth about their government's actions.

So, any form of censorship of the internet is a step away from an open and democratic society. The internet should therefore be free of censorship.

#### Aya:

I think that some form of internet censorship is justified for the following reasons.

First, total freedom of speech does not exist in any society. There are limits to what people can say in even the most democratic countries. If you didn't have laws against racist hate speech or threats, citizens would not be able to live secure lives. Why should the internet be different? Some censorship of social media posts or sites that encourage such things as terrorist acts is indispensable. Second, elections in democratic countries including the USA are often being influenced by fake news stories generated online to spread misinformation and to influence the way people vote. Surely, it is necessary to censor such sites to protect the democratic process from propaganda and lies.

Of course, to have as little censorship as possible of the internet should be the goal. However, if the internet were totally free of regulation, the security and stability of society would be seriously threatened.


